

TROLLS by THOMAS DAMBU in DL

Can You Find Them All?

Start your "troll adventure" in Detroit Lakes City Park at the troll named Alexa. Read the story in her book (it might be helpful to take pictures of the book pages), and follow the steps to solve the riddles and find the trolls.

As you find each troll, look at their necklace which includes a number and symbol.

- The symbol corresponds to a letter in the troll alphabet (which is in Alexa's book).
- The number corresponds to the placement order of the letter in a word.

Once you collect all the letters and put them in the right order, it will spell a word. That "secret" word is an item on the map in Alexa's book showing where the Golden Rabbit is located.

Don't like to play games? Go to www.TrollsDL.com, click on a troll, then click on their location. This will bring you to a Google Map to find the troll. This method works for all trolls, but not the Golden Rabbit. You'll still have to hunt for a bit to find the Golden Rabbit.

Hint: Follow the birdhouses that mark the trails and (somewhat) guide the way.

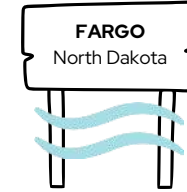

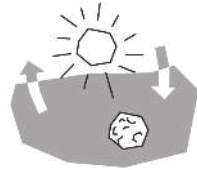
Alexa's Elixir

Twice as hard and twice as long, in what seemed like forever.

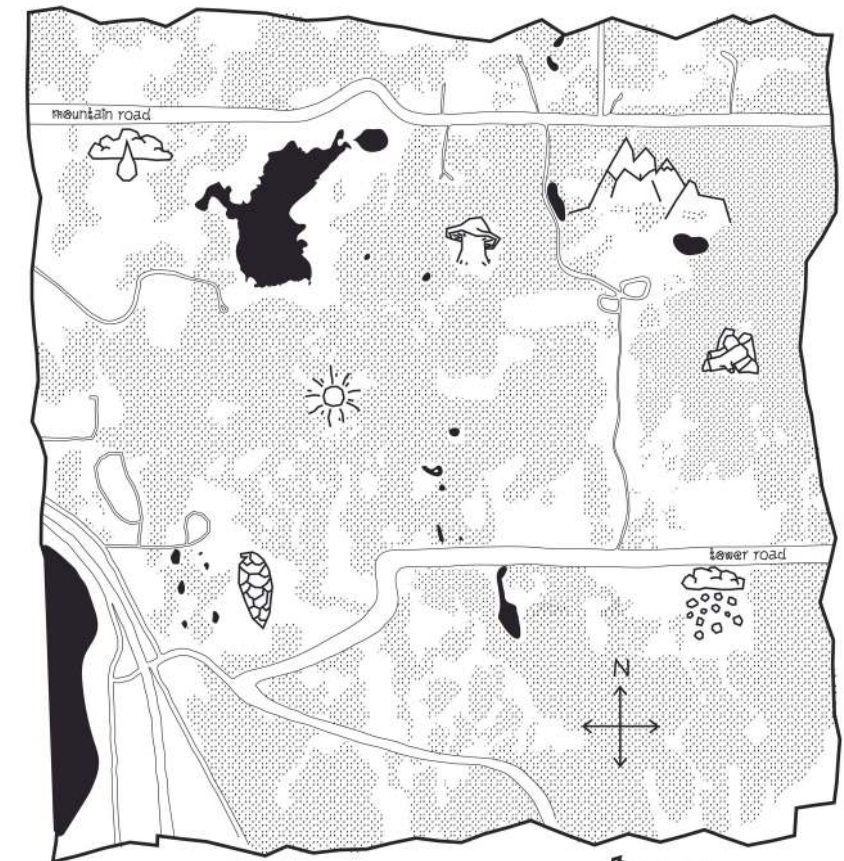


But as it is in stories, something unforeseen can happen

Add a story of love, and then put in a mile walked barefoot.



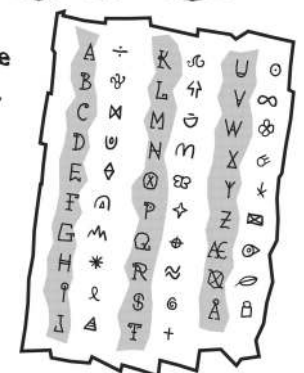
But as it is in stories, something unforeseen can happen
